Dear Praying Friends,

June 2016

We thank all of you for your faithful prayers and support for us as we continue in the service of the Lord Jesus Christ here in Soroti, Uganda.

Ministry: We ran two separate medical clinics this past quarter, one in the village and one in Kampala, the capital. We treated approximately one hundred fifty persons and we saw fifteen people saved! The clinic in the capital will be a potential new church plant by a well-established missionary colleague there in Kampala.

I have been discipling James, our guard who was saved back in March. He has shown great interest and growth in learning God's word. We are looking for a body of water to baptize him in and hope to do so very soon. We will do a medical clinic in his village of Awoja later in June and are praying for this village to be a possible church plant location in the future.

My colleagues and I have continued with our monthly Bible Institute, teaching local pastors and men at some of the church plants in the area studying through the book of Daniel. Many of these twenty or more men travel from quite a distance for these studies, and we are very thankful for their faithfulness in the study of the word of God.

The Bible Club in Oyomai Primary School resumed in late February and we finished ministering to the first and second grade students. We went through all of our teachings in about four weeks and saw twenty little hands raised for salvation! We thank the Lord for the tender hearts of children responding to the Gospel. We shall be looking for another Kumam speaking school to establish future Bible Clubs in our area.

Life in Uganda: Japhal, the boy with the bone infection has been doing very well, and his wound is almost closed now. His family actually lives quite far away from Soroti in another district. We are planning a visit with his family in the near future to share the Gospel with the entire household.

- Spiritual growth in discipleship for James.
- Salvation for Japhal and his family members.
- A new Kumam school in which to minister.
