**Dear Praying Friends,**

**March 2015**

We wish to thank all of you for your faithful prayers and support for the Lord's work in Uganda. We are grateful for the many blessings the Lord has provided in the work among the Ugandan people.

**Back in Uganda:** We arrived back in Uganda on January 14 after two uneventful flights. While in Kampala we paid a visit to our former clinic nurse, Richard, who was undergoing treatment for liver cancer. He did not look well, and even while on a new treatment we knew it was time for him to return to his family in Soroti. We drove him seven hours from Kampala back to his village outside Soroti to be with his wife, children and family where he died thirty-six hours later. He was saved and we are thankful he is no longer in pain. The funeral was almost eight hours long and though I was not asked to preach I gave a testimony of how Richard was such a great blessing at our clinic whose main purpose was to get the Gospel to every patient seen, which we did. Richard, at thirty-one years old, left behind a wife and three young girls. Life is so short, is it not? May we strive to impact people with the Gospel of Christ while the Lord gives us the opportunity on this earth.

**Ministry:** I have reconnected with Francis and Francis and have begun our discipleship lessons. Francis the pharmacy worker, brother of Richard, is well, but Francis the orphan has had a few rough months. He is safe and healthy and will expound further in our next prayer letter.

The Kumam church is going very well. We were blessed to find them faithfully meeting, preaching and reaching others in their villages with the Gospel. We plan to further Michael's (future pastor) training to refine his preaching and ministerial work among his people in the Kumam village.

We plan on doing several medical/evangelical clinics in the surrounding village areas in the next few months. Whether the patients are seriously ill or not, this has always been an effective way to reach people and sow hundreds of Gospel seeds among the lost.

Now that schools have begun we wish to begin our Bible Club ministry in Kumam-speaking primary schools soon. We teach the stories of Creation, Adam and Eve and the Plan of Salvation all spoken in the Kumam language. Please pray for much fruit from this ministry.
