Dear Praying Friends,

October 2014

Elena and I thank you for your faithful prayers and support for us as we continue on our furlough. We thank the Lord for His protection as we have traveled over sixteen thousand miles since May of this year. Our meetings have gone well and have prayed that we have been a blessing to our supporting churches as we update them about the Lord's work in Uganda.

A wonderful blessing for us was to witness the salvation of a young muslim woman at a meeting in one of our supporting churches. After the morning message, given by a fellow missionary, this young lady came forward to accept Christ as her saviour! She grew up in Africa, but has been living in the US for many years. We were told not to use her name or locale for fear of her family discovering her decision. This was an encouragement to us that muslims are indeed reachable, and we hope to make great inroads in reaching the muslims in Uganda by manifesting the love of Christ through the medical ministry, and to see many saved through preaching of the Gospel.

Back in Uganda one of the orphans, a healthy seventeen year old boy at the SOAP property, broke his arm a few months ago and upon x-ray a suspicious area was seen at the fracture site. The doctor frankly said this could be bone cancer so our missionary colleagues took him to an orthopaedic surgeon an hour away and a bone biopsy was performed. We thank the Lord the results were negative for cancer! Our colleagues report that "James" kept a mature and trusting testimony throughout his ordeal! Please pray that his fracture would heal completely, as the lytic lesion is still present and may delay the healing process.
