Thank you all for your faithful prayers and support as we continue in the ministry for the Lord Jesus Christ here in Soroti, Uganda.

Ministry: In July and August we held two medical clinics in villages outside of Soroti. Between the two we saw almost one hundred thirty patients and we thank the Lord for the thirty professions of faith that we witnessed! Prayers were answered!

I have begun preaching weekly at a security guard company in town after being invited to speak to about thirty-five guards before they report to their assignments. On my first visit I shared the Gospel and one man, who admitted to a past history of being a drunkard, accepted Christ as Savior! I wish to continue this ministry of sharing the Gospel, as well teach fundamental doctrines, to other guard companies and even in government schools, which is quite legal and acceptable in Uganda.

One of our former orphans came before the church two weeks ago to confess and ask forgiveness of his sin of fornication committed last year. In our grief he was dismissed from SOAP, but he has shown great commitment in restoring himself by moving away from the girl, working to save money for child support and for his future education. His confession was also made before his peers, which took courage, but was a great example of how, after committing sin, sincere repentance genuinely changes one's direction in life.

Life in Uganda: James, one of my former guards who was saved last year, has been coming to my home for discipleship for about eight months and has expressed his desire to attend my colleague's Bible college in Kampala stating, *"I want to learn so much more of the Bible and minister to my people in Awoja."* This is an absolute turnaround from where he was a year ago, spiritually lost and without a significant future. James becoming a Bible College student was the last thing I envisioned for him. Our God certainly does mighty works in lives of those who put their faith in Him as Savior.

We had a record number of men attend the Bible Institute in July. We thank the Lord for these dedicated men who wish to learn more of God's word, to become better preachers, and to assist the people in their villages to grow in the Lord Jesus Christ.

Prayer Requests:

- Spiritual growth for the men to lead their families for Christ.
- Salvation of souls in community outreach ministries.
- Direction for James as he seeks God's will, possibly Bible College.
